CLOTHES DONATION DRIVE ON DIWALI


Date: October 13, 2022

ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW RELATIONSHIP IN RESEARCH

Department of Science (Day-1)

Date: 21st January, 2023

Inaugural Ceremony

BICON is Biyani International Conference, which is held every year at Biyani Girls College, Jaipur, Rajasthan, India. This year institute organized the 17th anniversary of BICON from 21st January to 25th January 2023. The goal of the conference was to develop an interdisciplinary approach to fill the gap between the industry and academia. The first day of conference was organized by the Department of Science. The theme for day 1 was "Establishment of New Relationship in Research." The goal of BICON is to bring together top academics, Industrialists, researchers, and scientists to exchange information, create new approaches, and debate recent advancements in their respective fields. Collaboration between Industry and Academia will be encouraged by using futuristic pedagogies as well as stronger engagement between higher education and the industrial ecosystem. The Conference mainly focussed on Education, Psychological well-being, Faculty Capacity Building, Partnership, Skills, Employability, Research and Entrepreneurship. It aims to offer a fantastic

platform for receiving valuable input and a chance for connecting among researchers, academics, and industry leaders engaged in research and development.

Professor Manish Biyani addressed the audience and welcomed the Chief Guest Prof. J.P.Yadav, Vice Chancellor of Raj Rishi Bhartrihai Matsya University, Alwar; Guests of Honour Dr. Usha Dixit, Scientist-F at AI Division of Department of Science and Technology, Minister of Science & Technology, India; Mrs. Anita Kothari, Senior Vice Chairperson, Bhagwan Mahaveer Cancer Hospital and Research Centre, Jaipur; Chartered Accountant (CA) Mr. P.C. Modi, P C Modi & Company, Jaipur and other attendees. He described the breadth, upcoming initiatives, and his R&D contribution thus far.

The conference's keynote speaker, Prof. Masahiro Takagi from Japan Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (JAIST), Japan, led a detailed session on "Membrane Dynamics and Its Application to Biotechnology." He discussed the key findings of his research on the dynamics of surfactant membranes and described how to evaluate the irritation brought on by surfactants using the Corneal Cell Line Assay. He covered subjects like Langmuir-Blodgett,



cholesteric liquid crystals, lipid bilayer nature, and cell signal transmission in his lecture.

Oral Presentations were part of the conference's later sessions. On Day 1 of BICON 2022–23, researchers and students from several universities presented their theoretical and practical approaches to the following subthemes:

- Current Methods and Obstacles in the Search for New Cancer Drugs.
- New understandings of Material Functions at the Frontier of Active-Site Science.
- Experimental and Theoretical Investigations of Chemical Dynamics.
